Proposed orders must be signed by all sides in the case or by an attorney with a representation that presentation of the proposed order involves an agreement of the parties.
- (D) Parties should participate in pending cases at the Michael J. Sullivan Judicial Center remotely through CourtCall (courtcall.com / 888-882-6878) to the extent possible and feasible.
- (E) Requests for default judgments will likely result in a continuance past April or a default finding with prove-up after April.

Each Judge reserves the right to deviate from these preferences or implement such other preferences as their respective cases warrant. True emergencies will continue to be handled as needed.
