Judge Lee was appointed to serve as an associate judge in the Circuit Court of Cook County in May of 2014. In July 2014 he was reassigned to the 4<sup>th</sup> Municipal District in Maywood where he currently sits. In December 2014, the Supreme Court appointed Lee a member of the Judicial Conference of Illinois. Also in December 2014, the Supreme Court appointed Lee to the Alternative Dispute Resolution Coordinating Committee.

Immediately prior to being appointed to the bench, Lee was a partner with Greene and Letts for 16 years. His primary focus was the defense of employment and civil rights matters in state and federal court. Lee was a founding partner in the firm of Wilson, Lee & Davis where he practiced for 8 years. Lee began his legal career in the City of Chicago's Law Department as an Assistant Corporation Counsel.

Lee has litigated matters in most divisions of the Circuit Court of Cook County over the course of his 35-year legal career. He also has extensive experience in federal court, having appeared in over 100 federal cases. Lee has obtained numerous jury verdicts in civil and criminal matters in state and federal court. Lee is also a 1994 recipient of the Richard E. Westbrook award for excellence in civil law practice.

Lee was admitted to practice in the State of Illinois in 1983. He was subsequently admitted to the Northern District of Illinois; the Federal Trial Bar for the Northern District of Illinois; the Central District of Illinois; the Northern District of Indiana; the U.S. Court of Appeals for the 7th Circuit; and the U.S. Supreme Court. Lee is a former Board Member and Past President of the Cook County Bar Association.
